## **SPEAKERS**

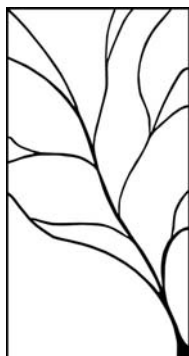
**Peter Hatch** – Director of Gardens and Grounds for the Thomas Jefferson Foundation ~ Charlottesville, VA  
Hatch has been responsible for the maintenance, interpretation, and restoration of the 2,400-acre landscape at Monticello since 1977. He has managed important restoration projects, such as the eight-acre Vegetable and Fruit Garden, the Grove – an ornamental forest of eighteen acres, and the establishment of the Thomas Jefferson Center for Historic Plants. He is the author of *The Gardens of Monticello* and the editor of *Thomas Jefferson's Flower Garden at Monticello* (University of Virginia Press).

**Ken Druse** – Author, Photographer, Lecturer, Radio Host ~ New York and New Jersey  
Druse has contributed to nearly every garden and home design magazine in America. He is probably best known for his books, which the *New York Times* called “bibles for serious gardeners.” His works include, *The Natural Shade Garden* (now in its 12th printing), *Making More Plants: The Science, Art, and Joy of Propagation* (which received “Award of the Year” from the Garden Writers Association), and his 17<sup>th</sup> and most recent work, *PLANTHROPOLOGY: The Myths, Mysteries, and Miracles of My Garden Favorites*.

**Marion Lobstein** – Associate Professor, NVCC / Adjunct Professor, Blandy Experimental Farm ~ Manassas, VA  
Lobstein is entering her thirty-sixth year teaching at Northern Virginia Community College. Her academic degrees include a BEd (biology) from Western Carolina University, MAT (concentration in botany) from UNC-Chapel Hill, and MS in biology from George Mason University. She developed a 45-minute video/DVD “Spring Wildflowers of the Mid-Atlantic Region,” and co-authored the book, *Finding Wildflowers in the Washington-Baltimore Area*.

**Steven Still** – Emeritus Professor, OSU / Executive Director, Perennial Plant Association ~ Hilliard, OH  
Still was an instructor of herbaceous and woody plant materials courses for 30 years at Kansas State and Ohio State Universities. He is the author of the *Manual of Herbaceous Ornamental Plants*, used as both a college text and for reference in the perennial industry. In 1983, he and four other perennial-industry icons started the Perennial Plant Association, for which he presently serves as the Executive Director. His plant images have appeared in numerous books and magazines and have been used to illustrate the Perennial Plant of the Year™.

**Cole Burrell** – Lecturer, Garden Designer, Author, Photographer ~ Charlottesville, VA  
Burrell is a designer, award winning author, photographer, naturalist, and educator. He has an MS in horticulture and an MLA from the University of Minnesota. He contributes to the monthly Plant Page feature for *Landscape Architecture*, and serves as contributing editor to *Horticulture*. His articles and photographs appear regularly in *Fine Gardening* and *American Gardener*. He has authored twelve books, including *Intimate Gardens*, *Perennial Combinations*, and *A Gardener's Encyclopedia of Wildflowers*.

## **DIRECTIONS**

**From Route 29 South:** Follow Rte 29 North (Culpeper) to 250 East Bypass (Richmond). Take Dairy Road/Meadowbrook Hts. Exit. Turn left at top of ramp, go across bridge, and continue on Grove Rd., which will curve to the right. Take second right, following signs to Martin Luther King, Jr. Performing Arts Center.

**From Route 29 North:** Follow Rte 29 South to 250 East Bypass. From 250 East Bypass, take Dairy Road/Meadowbrook Hts. Exit. Turn left at top of ramp, go across bridge, and continue on Grove Rd., which will curve to the right. Take second right, following signs to Martin Luther King, Jr. Performing Arts Center.

**From I-64 West:** Take Exit 118 – 29 North (Culpeper). Follow 250 East Bypass (Richmond). Take Dairy Road/Meadowbrook Hts. Exit. Turn left at top of ramp, go across bridge, and continue on Grove Rd., which will curve to the right. Take second right, following signs to Martin Luther King, Jr. Performing Arts Center.

**From I-64 East:** Exit 124 (Shadwell Exit) Turn right at bottom of ramp, onto 250 West Bypass. Turn right on Meadowbrook Hts. Road (Dairy Road/Meadowbrook Heights Exit). Turn right onto Grove Road. Take the next right, following signs to Martin Luther King, Jr. Performing Arts Center.

**From 250 East:** Follow 250 West Bypass. Turn right onto Meadowbrook Hts. Rd. (Dairy Road/Meadowbrook Heights Exit). Turn right onto Grove Road. Take the next right, following signs to Martin Luther King, Jr. Performing Arts Center.

**From 20 South:** From Rte 20, exit onto I-64 West. Take Exit 118-B to Rte 29 (Culpeper). Follow Rte 29 to 250 East Bypass. Take Dairy Road/Meadowbrook Hts. Exit. Turn left at top of ramp, cross bridge, and continue on Grove Road. Take second right, following signs to Martin Luther King, Jr. Performing Arts Center.
